Department of Music offers both undergraduate and graduate degrees. Undergraduate students receive a strong foundation in musicianship, giving them excellent preparation for graduate work and professional careers. With the opening of the campus's Music Center in 1997, a new era began for music at UC Santa Cruz. The state-of-the-art center has received rave reviews as one of the best music performance facilities in northern California. *Students selected may receive up to \$12,000 over four years. To receive the award each year, students must be registered full-time music majors in good standing. In addition to receiving scholarship funds, students selected for the program will join the student Resident String Ensemble and participate in a number of department-sponsored performances and public concerts. They will also receive lessons and have the opportunity to be coached by Roy Malan, concertmaster of the San Francisco Ballet and member of the UC Santa Cruz string faculty.

How To Apply Applicants must send a CD or cassette of two contrasting works (a total of 15–20 minutes of music) and a one-page outline of musical experience (instrument, years studied, orchestral experience, works performed). Be sure to include your name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address. Finalists will be invited to UCSC to meet with the string faculty and Director of Ensembles for an audition and interview in February of 2009. Finalists unable to attend the competition will be asked to submit a video of a recent performance.
